

GAME: Digging for Worms

THEMES:

God's Love & Searching for God

PARTICIPANTS: 2 是是

SUPPLIES: Table, 2 Cookie Sheets or Trays, Can of Redi-Whip, 20 Gummy Worms (10 per tray), & Googles (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Have a volunteer place 10 gummy worms on each tray, spreading them out across the tray. Then, spray a good layer of Redi-Whip on each tray, covering the gummy worms well.

Each participant will have 60 seconds to "dig out" as many worms as possible using only their mouths. Make sure their hands are behind their backs. Whoever has the most worms by the end of the 60 seconds is the winner.
