- Organizing, scheduling, and overseeing Organist, Soloists, Octet, Children/Youth Choir Director, and Hand Bell Directors
- Recruiting Chancel Choir members
- Assisting with publicizing musical events
- Coordinating the Church's music program with the Senior Pastor and Music Committee via meetings and other means of communication
- Obtaining a substitute music director acceptable to the Senior Pastor and the Music Committee in the event the Music Director must miss a rehearsal or performance (including remuneration to that person, if applicable)

- Meet with the Senior Pastor and Music Committee in scheduling performance groups for the 10:00 Sanctuary service
- Responsible for the purchase of any new music or other items for the Music Ministries
- Schedule the summer music program (July-August) for the Chapel and Sanctuary services
- Work with the Music Committee in recommending the budget for the music program
- Work with the Music Committee in auditioning and hiring new music staff personnel
- Hire any instrumentalists that may be required for special presentations
- Oversight of music program at the Cleveland campus as the opportunity and need develops
- Other duties as may be assigned
